KANS organized a scientific competition among inventors, scholars, university students, and professors (under 45 years of age) throughout Islamic countries. This event aims at finding the best scientific solutions to spot and tackle the challenges of society.

The competition is held in 6 main subjects including;

1. Energy, Water & Environment.
2. Health & Med-tech.
3. ICT & AI.
4. Electronics, and Robotics.
5. Agriculture and Food Industries.
6. Mining and Mineral Industries.

Young scholars can participate in this competition by submitting their scientific achievements or their innovative solutions for challenges declared by international scientific institutions. Scientific achievements and solutions, in the form of 3 to 5 minute videos, should be uploaded on the competition website **kans.mstfdn.org**.

In the videos, participants describe a summary of their scientific achievements and suggested solutions. Scientific achievements and solutions could be presented in the form of Idea, Paper, Book, Prototype, MVP, or New product.

The 6 winners will be awarded:

- KANS Medal and Plaque of Appreciation.
- 30-gram Gold Insignia.
- Special privileges for benefiting from MSTF networking platforms as well as Young Scientists Fellowship Program (YSFP) worth \$2000.

Join expert trainers and your international education community on 22 and 24 February for a hands-on course that will explore how to provide effective support for international students who are facing mental health challenges. Understand the dynamics of psychological referrals and confidentiality

- Become aware of the stressors that continue to impact on the international student population, alongside the psychological and sociological effect of the Pandemic.
- Learn how to recognise signs of psychological distress and warning signs among students that require immediate intervention.
- Understand how students cope with psychological distress, and how to distinguish between positive and negative coping.
