Officials from Azerbaijan Ministry of Education, the Embassy representatives, Members of Parliament, University Rectors and Education Specialists participated in the conference.



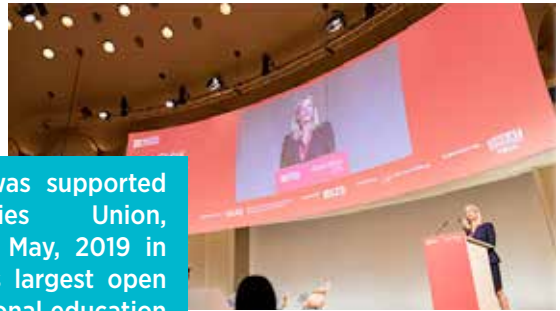
EURAS Annual Meeting

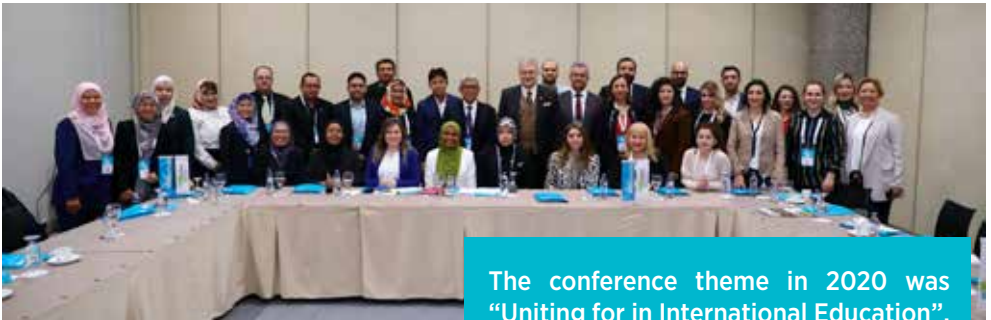

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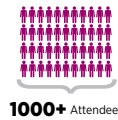

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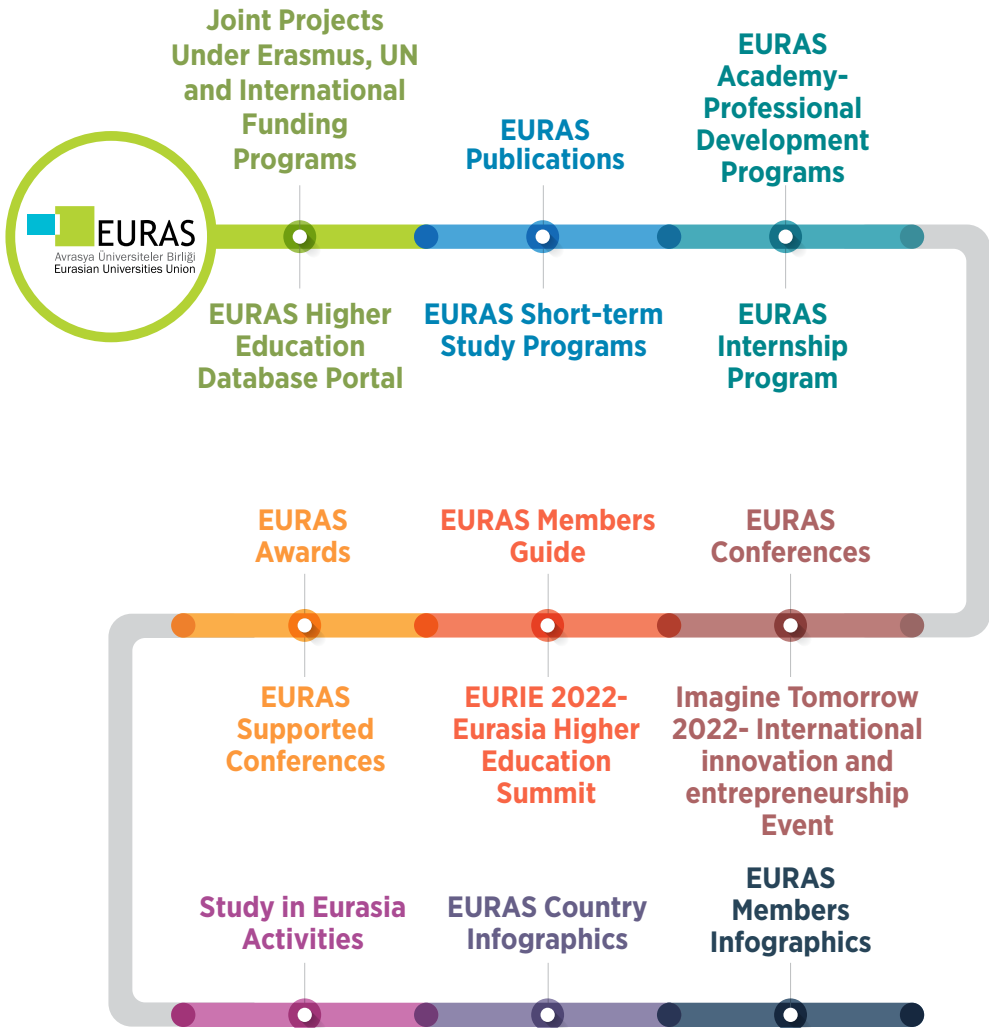
