

This Coimbra Group member universities have launched a scholarship programme aimed at young researchers and staff from universities in Latin America, Sub-Saharan Africa, and the European Neighbourhood. The programme offers 90 scholarships to young professors and researchers who are both national and residents of the aforementioned regions.

The scholarship programme will enable scholars to internationalise the research they perform at their home institution and establish academic and research contacts in Europe. The initiative will specifically support short-term research visits to one of the 20 participating universities on the European Continent.

How to apply

Applications for the scholarship programme should be submitted online through the official Coimbra Group website. Each regional scholarship programme has specific requirements, and a letter of acceptance must be provided by an academic supervisor at the host university.
