



❖ THE - The Asian university in 2050 on 21-23 June 2023, Hong Kong

The rise of Asia's universities has been one of the most significant developments in the recent history of higher education. The region has increased its representation from a quarter to a third of all institutions listed in the THE World University Rankings over the past five years.

While the region's performance mirrors global shifts in GDP, the higher education story is also one of strong public investment in the sector, a commitment to internationalisation, and strong cultural capital attached to the importance of universities.

But issues such as an uncertain geopolitical outlook, vast income differences across the region, and the economic and social aftershocks of a global pandemic will shape the next phase of Asia's growth up to the midpoint of the 21st century.

Hosted in partnership with The Chinese University of Hong Kong, the THE Asia Universities Summit 2023 will focus on the fundamental question – is there such a thing as a distinctly “Asian” university in such an economically, culturally and socially diverse region? What will it mean to be an Asian university in 2050?

❖ UNIMED: Migration and Mobility in the Digital Age: apply by June 10th, 2023 for this Summer Training School

From 3 July to 7 July 2023 it will held the third edition of the Summer Training School "Migration and Mobility in the Digital Age" in hybrid form: online and onsite at the University of Tuscia (Viterbo, Italy).

This Summer Training School (STS) is organised by the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence on the Integration of Migrants in Europe (IntoME).

Launched in September 2020 at the University of Tuscia, IntoME is an international study and research platform for the analysis of migration processes, with a particular focus on integration issues in the EU (www.intome.eu). Academics and high-level experts with a strong competence in immigration, asylum, inclusion and integration studies are involved in the Centre's initiatives to promote excellence in research and teaching activities.

The third edition of the STS will provide Master's and PhD students as well as practitioners with a comprehensive and in-depth understanding of four key aspects:

- the progressive digitalization of EU borders and its socio-political consequences;
- the fundamental rights implications of data-driven borders;
- the accountability concerns and regulatory aspects behind the use of digital technologies to manage migratory movements;
- the role of new technologies in the integration of migrants.

These dimensions will be explored from a variety of perspectives, including legal, political, social and economic.
